Edward Johann Knuth

Edward Knuth was buried from Grace Evangelical Luthern Church in Augusta, Wisconsin on November 21, 1964. The spelling of his name

in the church records was Eduard, which I believe is the German spelling for Edward.

Edward Johann Knuth was baptised on December 24, 1882 and confirmed on April 11, 1897 from Grace Evangelical Lutheran Church, Augusta, Wisconsin.

This newpaper article contained a bit of information about Edward Knuth.

On July 31,1930, Willard Johnson was severly bitten on the head by a police dog, but is recovering A severe wind storm struck the Augusta area doing much damage, lightning struck the William Albright home making a hole in the roof and nearly all the furnishings in the house were soaked with water ... Ed Knuth met with a painful accident when sawing a stick for his grader with a power saw and in picking off a small chip, his left hand was drawn into the saw and was badly mangled, resulting in the loss of his thumb and parts of fingers.

Edward Knuth, son of Carl (Charles) Knuth and Wilhelmine Lambrecht was born in Augusta, Wisconsin. He attended the Dells School. Edward was confirmed at Grace Evangelical Lutheran Church in Augusta, Wisconsin by Rev. Prohl.

After marrying Augusta Bauch, Ed and Augusta lived in Augusta, Wisconsin until 1910, when they moved to Canada, where they homesteaded. They returned to Augusta, Wisconsin in 1917, They settled on a farm in the Town of Bridge Creek. In 1930 Edward obtained employment with Eau Claire County as a patrolman. For a number of years before his retirement, he worked as a carpenter. Edward and Augusta had 10 children.

According to Roy Knuth, son of Edward and Augusta Knuth, they lived in Tribune, Sask., Canada for 6 years. Roy said he was a baby when they went to Canada, and he was 7 years old when they came back to the United States.

Edward Knuth, 82, Augusta, Wisconsin, died Wednesday at Sacred Heart Hospital in Eau Claire, Wisconsin where he had been taken earlier in the day.

Funeral service will be held Saturday at 2:00 p.m. at Grace Lutheran Church in Augusta with Rev. F. G. Schedler officiating. Burial will be in the West Lawn Cemetery.

Born in Augusta, Wisconsin, Mr. Knuth married Augusta Bauch in 1907 and the couple moved to
